



College Fee Guidance

Each year we invest significant sums into the infrastructure of the College to increase the experience of the students attending courses. These enhancements add value to the whole student experience, and may provide the edge when applying their skills, but aren't necessary for students to achieve their course.

To help pay for these investments, the College charges a College Administration Fee to all adult learners studying a Further Education course at Vantage Point. The fee is tiered at £100, £50 and £25 depending on the size of the course students are enrolled on.

Here are some of the things we make available to students:

High speed internet access - whether through our wireless or computers, the internet is always on and provides a secure and fast way to access the internet.

BYOD - the IT infrastructure enables students to 'bring your own devices' (BYOD) onto site and access files and the internet in a secure and safe way.

Job Shop - vacancies from local employers are regularly promoted through the Job Shop, often exclusively, and with some large local employers. The service can also help you with C.V. writing and interview preparation.

Visiting speakers - a number of courses invite guest speakers into their courses to provide industry specific information to our students.

Microsoft Office 365 - 1 Terabyte of storage is available with the ability to install Microsoft Office on up to 5 devices together with a suite of online resources.

Print credits - all students are given £10 worth of printing credits to get them started with their printing needs.

USB charge points - to keep your own devices charged.

Additional learning materials - a number of courses purchase additional materials to enhance students' ability to achieve. Some of these are only available through the College and include past exam papers and case material.

Software upgrades - where suitable the College purchases the latest software versions such as Sage, and the Adobe suite. These versions are not needed to achieve the course but provide students with the edge when applying their skills.

Specialist course equipment - from 3D printers to high end cameras, Macs and PC, and iPads, the College has invested in these to enhance the student experience whilst on course and make them available to students.
