Activity 1	<p>Preparation for The Tudors module:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Study the information from the Wars of the Roses family tree.</li><li>• The two main families involved were called the Yorkists and the Lancastrians.</li><li>• Each family has a rose as their family symbol hence the name 'Wars of the Roses'.</li><li>• Answer the questions which follow the family tree.</li></ul> <p>Tasks:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Trace the Yorkist line and the Lancastrian line (if possible to print the family tree, or use editing software, use a different colour for each family line).</li><li>• Question 1: Edward IV won the throne off Henry VI. Who had a better claim to the throne and why?</li><li>• Question 2: What was Henry VII's claim to the throne?</li><li>• Question 3: Do you think Henry VII's marriage was a wise or silly choice?
